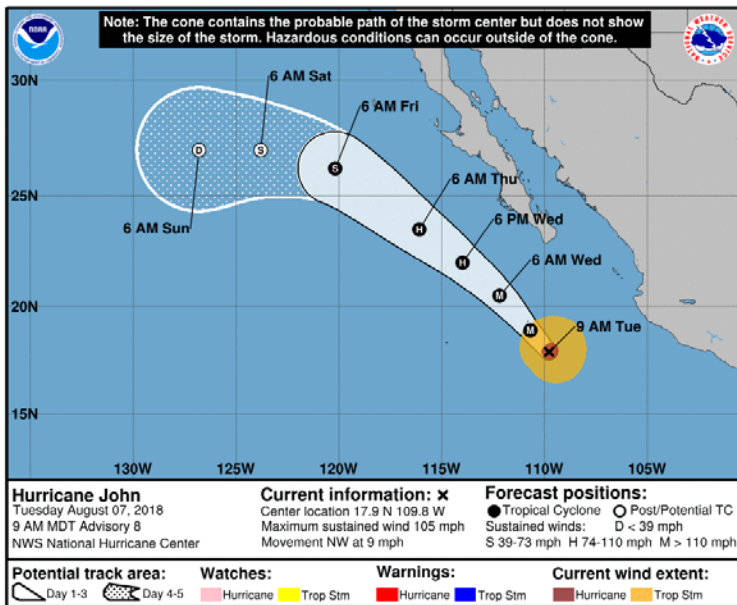

HURRICANE JOHN

The Avalon Harbor Department received communication from the National Weather Service yesterday that, "Hurricane John, a major hurricane currently south of Baja California, will move to the northwest through the weekend and slowly weaken each day after Wednesday. The center of the storm will get as close as 500 miles to the southwest of Los Angeles, with the extreme outer bands possibly reaching the coastal waters of California. This will bring a large SSE swell to California Wednesday through Monday – peaking Friday and Saturday. Meanwhile, very large astronomical tides between 7.0 and 7.5 feet are expected each evening from now through Sunday."

This may mean that the Avalon Harbor Patrol will have to pull up all of the dinghy dock and float ramps during the high tides.
