



Rules for Riding

Packages

No more than you can personally carry on and off. Packages cannot obstruct aisle or prevent seats from being used by other passengers.

Service Animals

Service animals may accompany their disabled individual at all times on Avalon Transit services. During travel, the individual is responsible for the behavior of their service animal.

Pets

Pets are not allowed on Avalon Transit vehicles unless they are transported in an enclosed pet carrier.

Rider Conduct

Please, no eating, smoking (including electronic devices) or drinking from uncovered containers is allowed on-board Avalon Transit buses. Cell phones and music players may be used while on Avalon Transit vehicles so long as an earpiece or headphones are used, with volume low enough not to disrupt other passengers.

Title VI Nondiscrimination Policy

A curb-to-curb, immediate request, shared-ride paratransit service for seniors 65+ and individuals with disabilities that do not necessarily prevent them from using the Garibaldi fixed route bus. Service is provided on a space-available basis.
